



Starr's Mill High School 9th Grade Electives Requests Selection Process 2012-2013

Directions: Elective request selections will be made using the Infinite Campus student portal. Please use these instructions to make elective selections. Registration Portal Open for rising 9th graders: February 28 - March 5, 2012

Steps for making elective request selections:

1. Go to the Starr's Mill High School website www.starrsmillhighschool.org and click on the Infinite Campus portal link on the left side of the home page.
2. Login to the Infinite Campus portal using your user name and password.
3. Click the Registration option from the index on the left of the screen.
4. Required courses may be listed. You may not change any required courses listed. If there is an issue or mistake, those can be cleared by putting your concerns in writing and giving them to our counselors at the Orientation on February 28th or when you get your list of class requests in May the request form will have a place to address any concerns.
5. Click the Course Search link. A search screen will appear.
6. In order of preference using the attached electives sheet, enter the course number for a 1st semester course which you are interested in or searching by course name by put in only the first three letters since many course names are abbreviated in Infinite Campus.
7. Click the Go button. Matching courses will appear on the right.
8. Click on any course to review the course description.
9. To request this course, click the Request as Elective button at the bottom. You will notice that the Units amount will go up by one.
10. Next, enter in the Course Number search field the 2nd semester course number that corresponds with the 1st semester one you just requested. Click the course from the list on the right, and then click the Request as Elective button. Again the Units amount will go up by one. Remember to request BOTH the 1st semester and corresponding 2nd semester course.
11. Repeat the process with your next course until the Units amount equals 12/12 (or 14 /12 if you are taking a zero period class). Depending on the courses that were entered administratively, you may be entering 0-4 courses to complete 12/12 units or 14/12 if taking zero period.
12. Next, search for courses, in order of preference, you would like to list as alternates in the event your requested courses are not available. Follow the same procedure, but click **Request as Alternate** instead of Request as Elective. Remember to repeat the process for the 2nd semester class that corresponds with the fall semester one you requested.
13. Please choose 4-6 alternates. Students who do not choose alternates will be placed into available electives in the event that their original requests are full. This information will be used to build you schedule for the following year.
14. When you have finished requesting courses, click the Print Request Summary option to print a report of the courses you have selected.
15. Click Log Off option from the left index.

Please plan on attending the Rising 9th grade Orientation on February 28, 2012, at 6:30 pm at SMHS starting in the Gym. The portal will be open after the orientation meeting until March 5, 2012.
